UNICALCE S.p.A. considers environmental protection and sustainable development of strategic importance for its activities and considers compliance with legal obligations as an imperative prerequisite for all its activities.

It is therefore committed to:

- progressively implement within the entire organization an Environmental Management System certified according to the UNI EN ISO 14001:2015 standard and extend EMAS registration to all operational sites with the goal of identifying, evaluating and monitoring the environmental features interrelated to its activities and services, ensuring the observance of compliance obligations and pursuing continuous improvement of its environmental performance;
- undertake an evaluation of processes and connected environmental elements by identifying the appropriate metrics, to then evaluate risks and related opportunities;
- check and, if it's possible, mitigate environmental impacts by applying the best available technologies for the design and conversion of production plants;
- manage production plants in order to improve, as much as possible, performance related with environmental matters and prevent pollution, by also considering the needs and expectations of stakeholders;
- Optimize the use of natural resources, by particularly favouring the use of renewable energy sources;
- Plan and manage its quarry activities so to protect local biodiversity and ecosystems;
- train staff on environmental issues, pursuing the required and committed cooperation;
- raise awareness and qualify suppliers and contractors and provide them with certification, with particular reference to the environmental protection and compliance with environmental standards;
- communicate to stakeholders the results obtained in the field of environmental protection and performance of its EMAS registered sites.
